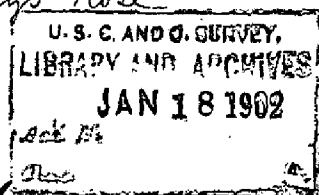

## Descriptive Report-



In making this survey, for the purpose of furnishing shore line for the hydrographic sheet, the old shore line was first transferred in pencil from tracings sent from the office. The shore line was then carefully examined and whenever new wharves or other changes were noticed a new survey was made.

On Jona Island the Navy Department is making extensive improvements and many new buildings are in course of erection but the work is still incomplete. The engineers in charge have plans on a large scale showing all changes, which can be procured from the Dept. when the work is finished and transferred to the topographic sheet. The new wharf line and the position of the stake light at the north end and the large water tower is indicated on the sheet.
