

The sheet herein described extends from Swan Creek to FILE:

Oxon Run or the PEFE Poundary of the District of Columbia.

ASSISTANTIN CI.

The principal feature of this area is the system of watersheds made by Froad Creek, the Potomac and Cxon Run which divide at the ridge on which Fort Foote stands, meeting therein a bluff eighty feet high. The Geological formation does not in any respect differ from that indicated for Sheets Nos 1 and 2. The ridge beginning at Fort Foote on the River extends by a long curve gradually receding to the North East until the water shed of Oxon Run is reached.

The conditions before noted for Sheet No.1 are similar to those common to this Sheet.

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
