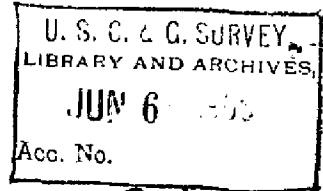

Resurvey of the Potomac River
Piney Point to Point-Sockout,
Saint-Mary's County Maryland
Interior Maps, Containing Tracts &c."



The Country from Piney Point to Point-Sockout, is low and flat, the highest elevation being 60 feet above mean high water on the Potomac River,

The Country surveyed is partly timberland interspersed with fine farms under a good state of cultivation. There are good Wharves at Piney Point, Saint-Georges Island on the Saint-Mary's River, Smith's Creek and at Point-Sockout Light-House. The Baltimore Steam Vessels make three trips a week to and from Baltimore and Washington at all of these Wharves, except the latter one.

Piney Point, Saint-Georges Island and Denton in Smith's Creek. are Secured over results, and are freely patronized by Washington and Baltimore guests,
