Descriptive Report to Accompany Topographic Sheet No.3454,
West Side of Parramore Island, Virginia.

This sheet was used only for the purpose of determining by plane table triangulation enough objects for the control of surveys of Little Beach Cove and Sting Ray Point Cove. The surveys were made on separate sheets (on a scale of 1:5000) on which were plotted the positions of the objects determined here. The lines of sights are shown by full or broken lines, full lines indicating that sights were taken at both ends and broken lines that they were sighted over in but one direction.

The position of the windmill at Revel Island Club, which had been determined by theodolite sights intersecting at an angle of about 10 degrees, was verified by plane table.
