DESCRIPTIVE REPORT

To accompany topographic sheet of Carquinez Straits, California .

Instructions of July 2, 1926.

A Topographic revision was made of that section shown on photostat of topographic 1696b (enclosed). This work was done between December 11. and December 28, 1926.

CONTROL:

Numerous triangulation stations were recovered within the limits of the sheet, furnishing excellent control. No closing errors were experienced. The scale is 1:10,000. It will be noted that the triangulation station Grove is plotted in error on the photostat. Although the sheet was seasoned before being projected it has contracted about 4 meters per minute North and South, and 9 meteres per minute East & West.

SHORE LINE:

It was thought advisable to completely rerun the shore line, on account of changes noted as follows:

The Old Associated Oil Dock at Suisum Point is gone and repplaced by a new one 450 meters to the NE.

Part of the Tule flat has been reclamed where the Shell Oil Dock crosses the high water line.

Grangers Wharf is in a dilapidated condition and therefore shown with broken line on topo. Sheet.

The Nevada Docks at Port Costa Brickworksare gone, a few old pilings are still in evidence.

The Yerba Dock has been burnt and charred piling only remain.

GENERAL:

The sheet is complete between low water and the railroad tracks on both sides of the Straits. No important changes were noted in the town of Benicia. California.

The topography on this sheet was done by E.A.Deily, and this report was made up from chotes left by him.

- 6. The character and scope of the surveying are excellent. The field drafting is excellent except in one respect -- the projection lines are one-half millimeter thick.
