28 DETAILING:

The eastern limit of survey T-5991 divides Pemaquid Neck. For best control of the eastern portion of Pemaquid Neck, it appeared desirable to detail this part of the area of T-5438 on the map drawing for survey T-5991. Since the projection for map drawing T-5991 had adequate eastward extension, this has been done. Survey T-5991 is part of subproject CS 272-B. In this sub-project, detailing of shoreline features and adjacent culture only is required. Survey T-5438 is part of subproject CS 272-C. In this sub-project, detailing of complete planimetric detail including that of the interior is required.

The shoreline and immediate adjacent culture have been detailed on this map drawing in accordance with the Director's letters dated January 12, 1942, and April 1, 1942, pertaining to sub-project CS 272-B.

The shoreline and interior culture of the eastward extension to include part of the area of Survey T-5438, have been detailed on this map drawing in accordance with the Director's letters dated January 12, 1942, and April 1, 1942, pertaining to sub-project CS 272-C.

The areas pertaining to sub-projects Nos. CS 272-B and CS 272-C have been noted on the map drawing.

All detail on this map drawing has been shown by the standard symbols recommended by the Washington Office and notes fully describing any deviation therefrom appear on the overlay sheet in order that the planimetry may be clearly interpreted by those concerned.

In some areas, considerable difficulty was encountered in establishing the positions of tertiary points due to relief displacement, dense vegetation along the shoreline and an insufficient number of photographs.

Small purple and green ink circles, on the glossy side of this map drawing, indicate positions of tertiary points which are relatively strong or weak respectively.

28 DETAILING: (Cont'd.)

The field inspection party did not submit any data to assist the compiler in identifying bluffs along the shoreline. Therefore, they were detailed according to stereoscopic examination of the office photographs. It is believed the character of all bluffs within the detail limits (original and extended) of this map drawing is rocky and therefore were shown with the standard rock bluff symbol.

The U. S. Engineers had established a horizontal control scheme in New Harbor. This was not available for control of the map drawing because no geographic positions of the stations were available. Distances and directions of the U. S. Engineer observations were furnished the compilation office by the Washington Office. The field inspection party recovered twelve stations of the eighteen station scheme. Four of these twelve stations were identified on the photographs by field inspection stations. The other eight recovered stations were either picked direct on the photographs or identified by measurements to nearby points of well defined detail. The four F.I.S. points and the eight recovered stations otherwise identified were located on the map drawing by radial plot. Three of the stations identified by F.I.S. points were then plotted by graphic methods. The position of station VI was computed as follows:

From the scaled geographic position of F.I.S. "Back," direction angle from F.I.S. "Back" to U.S.E. triangulation station "G" (by sextant), forward azimuth U.S.E. triangulation station VI to U.S.E. triangulation station "G" and distance from "VI" (U.S.E.) to "G" (U.S.E.)

The positions of the entire group were then examined according to the distances between stations from the U. S. Engineer's data. Agreement was excellent.

These twelve stations are shown with $2\frac{1}{2}$ mm. black acid ink circles. Their positions and descriptions are being furnished on Forms No. 524.

During the progress of compilation on this map drawing, it became necessary to send the uncompleted drawing to the Washington Office for reproduction to obtain needed data for a hydrographic party operating in the area. In completing the map drawing, it was discovered that U.S.E. station H-H had not been correctly radial plotted. Therefore the position of this station on all copies made of the uncompleted map drawing is incorrect. Its position on the completed map drawing is correct.

It was impossible to identify accurately the true shape and size of most of the buildings on Inner Heron Island and on the southeast side of Linekin Neck due to dense foliage.

The position of the shoreline in the following areas is considered relatively weak:

The south tip of Spruce Point
The southwest tip of Linekin Neck known as Ocean Point
The north and south ends of Negro Island.

28 DETAILING: (Cont'd.)

The entire shoreline of Little River
The eastern shoreline of Linekin Neck from Little River
north to the town of East Boothbay. This latter area has
been outlined with red ink on the map drawing.

The shoreline in the above areas was detailed from the positions of tertiary points determined by the intersection of only two radials. Dense vegetation and an insufficient number of photographs prevented this compilation office from identifying detail points on a sufficient number of photographs, in order that their positions could be determined by the intersection of three or more radials.

Roads shown within the original detail limits of this map drawing have been classified by this compilation office because no classification was submitted by the field inspection party.

Roads shown within the extended limits were classified in accordance with the submitted field inspection data.

The classification of all areas of vegetation shown within the extended limits on the map drawing is in accordance with the submitted field inspection data.

The position of one "U.S.E. B.M." Elev. 18.49 ft. was radial plotted and shown with a $2\frac{1}{2}$ mm. black acid ink circle in conjunction with the usual symbol. The position and description of this bench mark has been submitted on Form No. 524.

30 MEAN HIGH WATER LINE:

The mean high water line (firm ground) has been shown by a solid heavy-weight black acid ink line, the center of which should be taken as the true position.

31 LOW WATER AND SHOAL LINES:

The approximate limits of rock ledges have been detailed in accordance with the submitted field inspection data and have been shown with a dashed light-weight black acid ink line. These limits are for the use of the hydrographer only and they should not be accepted as indicating the true positition of the mean low water line. Notes have been shown on the overlay sheet to assist in identifying these areas.

32 DETAILS OFFSHORE FROM HIGH-WATER LINE:

The approximate limits of reefs were detailed in accordance with the field inspection data and have been shown with dashed light-weight black acid ink lines. Notes have been shown on the overlay sheet to assist in identifying these areas.

Rocks have been shown in accordance with the field inspection data. The extent to which rocks bare at Mean High Water or Mean Low Water has been shown on the overlay sheet.

32 DETAILS OFFSHORE FROM HIGH-WATER LINE: (Cont'd.)

N.B. The time noted on the field inspection photographs covering the area pertaining to sub-project No. CS 272-B is Eastern Standard Time. The time noted on the field inspection photographs covering the area pertaining to sub-project No. CS 272-C is Eastern War Time (Daylight Saving Time).

33 WHARVES AND SHORELINE STRUCTURES:

Piers, wharves, bridges, etc., were shown on this map drawing in accordance with the submitted field inspection data.

34 LANDMARKS AND AIDS TO NAVIGATION:

The following three (3) recommended landmarks have been shown on this map drawing by $2\frac{1}{2}$ mm. black acid ink circles, and their radial plotted geographic positions have been submitted on form No. 567:

Flag pole, 40 ft. high, white, on south tip of Jones Point.
Flag pole, 40 ft. high, white, on white rock point, on east shore of Linekin Bay.
Spire, church, on south end of, in East Boothbay.

35 HYDROGRAPHIC CONTROL:

The positions of forty (40) recoverable topographic stations and two hundred and seventy-five (275) temporary hydrographic stations have been established on this map drawing by radial intersection or, in a few cases, by detailing from positions of surrounding detail points. Twenty-five (25) of the recoverable topographic stations and two hundred and sixty-two (262) of the temporary hydrographic stations are in the area of Survey T-5991. Fifteen (15) of the recoverable topographic stations and thirteen (13) of the temporary hydrographic stations are in the area of Survey T-5438.* The recoverable topographic stations and temporary hydrographic stations have been shown by $2\frac{1}{2}$ mm. and $1\frac{1}{2}$ mm. black acid ink circles respectively. * This section is the same of that achieve was complete topographic stations.

These two lists should supersede the combined list previously submitted. The two revised lists have been submitted as an appendix to this report. Two additional copies of the appendix have been submitted for use of the hydrographic party.

The limits of the two cable crossing areas shown on this map Review drawing by parallel dashed red acid ink lines were transferred from Chart No. 313, scale 1:40,000 by use of the projector and are approximate.

39 RECOMMENDATIONS FOR FUTURE SURVEYS:

The shoreline and interior culture shown on this map drawing is believed to be complete in all details of importance for charting and no additional surveys are recommended, except for the area outlined in red ink. A note has been shown on the map drawing and overlay sheet calling attention to this area. The position of the shoreline and immediate adjacent culture within the above mentioned area was considered relatively weak by this compilation office because of reasons previously discussed in this descriptive report. Plane table survey has been recommended for this area.

39 RECOMMENDATIONS FOR FUTURE SURVEYS: (Cont'd)

It is believed the probable error in the positions of radial points and well defined objects along the shoreline is not greater than 0.5 mm. except the positions of the detail points and shoreline within the area discussed in the preceding paragraph. It is believed the error in the positions of inland radial points and details of importance is not greater than 1.0 mm.

40 BRIDGES OVER NAVIGABLE WATERS:

All necessary data pertaining to bridges has been shown on the overlay sheet.

N.B. The time noted on the field inspection photographs covering the area pertaining to sub-project No. CS 272-B is Eastern Standard Time. The time noted on the field inspection photographs covering the area pertaining to sub-project No. CS 272-C is Eastern War Time (Daylight Saving Time).

41 PIPE LINE:

The pipe line shown on this map drawing by a dashed black acid ink line has been detailed directly from the field inspection photograph. It could not be identified on any office photographs. It is indicated by the note "Water pipe to Squirrel Island" on the overlay sheet.

42 GEOGRAPHIC NAMES:

Geographic names shown on the map drawing are from data submitted by the field inspection party. A list of undisputed and disputed names is included in this report. A special report on the investigation of geographic names has been submitted by the field inspection party.

44 COMPARISON WITH EXISTING TOPOGRAPHIC QUADRANGLES:

Boothbay Quadrangle (15') U.S.G.S., scale 1:62,500; edition 1893, reprint 1941.

Due to difference in scale between this map drawing and the above mentioned quadrangle, planimetric details could not be readily compared. In general, however, planimetry common to both is in fair agreement.

REVIEW REPORT Shoreline Map T-5991 DAMARISCOTTA RIVER, Johns Bay-Linekin Bay & Vic. Me. 1941-1942

Subjects not used in this review report are adequately covered in the Descriptive Report, or are inapplicable.

26: CONTROL Sufficient control was in evidence to insure the required accuracy for this survey.

27: RADIAL PLOT A check was made during review of the radial plot for T5991. Results were satisfactory.

28: DETAILING & FIELD INSPECTION The compilation of some sections of this map was quite difficult, since only two-cut tertiary points were available for detailing. (SEE ALSO DESCRIPTIVE REFORT) pp. 5, 6, 7) The notation in red ink in that paragraph will be explained in this report under 43b, below.

Rock ledge, rock awash and reef symbols shown on this map in red ink were supplied during the review of the hydrographic surveys covering that area. In order to expedite the review of this sheet, these symbols were not continued throughout the remaining portion of the sheet. A note pertaining to this has been made on the manuscript in red ink. Since the major portion of the area covered by T-5991 is also covered by H-6844, the reviewer believes that reference can be made to the hydrographic sheet for these features.

All approximate shoal lines detailed during compilation were removed during review. References to reefs and to some rocky ledge were allowed to remain on the overlay sheet merely to indicate their approximate position and to help locate them when reference was made to H-6844.

Field inspection in the area of this survey was adequate.

30. MEAN HIGH WATER LINE

The position of the shoreline in a few areas is considered relatively weak. This is duscussed under paragraph 28 of the Descriptive Report. However, some correction has been made during review, and this will be described under 43b, below

Small island at the mouth of Little River - shown attached to Linekin Neck on T-5991 and unattached on the Quad.

Northeast corner of Linekin Bay - On the Quad a peninsula on Linekin Neck juts out into the Bay and just east of the peninsula a cove with an island in it is shown. On T-5991 the peninsula is shown as an island, the cove has been made very small by a dam (approximate position: Lat.43° 51' 35" Long. 69° 35' 25") and the lake formed by the dam has no island in it.

Survey T-5991 supersedes both Quadrangles in their common areas.

Negro Island: - on the map there is an island to the east of this island, on charts 313 and 314 there is a peninsula on Negro Island.

Northeast corner of Linekin Bay: - on charts 313 and 314 same as in Quads mentioned above, excepting the island in the cove, T-5991 same as above.

The Gut: - chart 313 shows a pier partly across this body of water, the map has a bridge across it as well as a fill most of the way across with buildings on it.

Island in Christmas Cove: - on map it is connected to Rutherford Island by a wooden foot bridge, on chart 313 it is unattached.

Thread of Life Ledges: - the lower group of islands in this chain has three fair sized islands on chart 313, on the map there are only two.

Island at mouth of Little River: - on map it is shown connected to Linekin Neck; on chart 313 it is unattached.

Bridge across Little River: - this bridge connects two large peninsulas that jut out into Little River near its northern end; on chart 313 the bridge connects the western shores of these peninsulas, on the map it is narly over to the eastern shores.

Survey T-5991 had previously been applied to charts. following change has been reported to Nautical Charts:

> "Correction of shoreline between East Boothbay and Little River on Linekin Neck and the northern top of Reeds Island."

Nautical Charts was notified of this change on 18 Sept, 1945.
