AUTHORITY

The work covered by this report was accomplished in accordance with the instructions in the Director's letter of July 22, 1943, reference 826-RCR.

PURPOSE AND SCOPE

The work was executed to establish definitely the shore line along the west shore of the Damariscotta River between East Boothbay and Reed Island where accurate compilation of air photographic survey T-5991 was prevented by deep shadows on the photographs.

METHODS

The survey was made by planetable traverse between the signals located on the air photographic survey. Distances were by stadia and orientation by alidade upon the most distant of the visible signals on either shore.

RESULTS

The shoreline as determined agrees substantially with that shown by air photographic survey T-5991 although minor details and the low-water line were disclosed in greater detail. In most cases only one set up of the planetable was necessary between successive signals so that closures were well within those allowable.
