McGregor's Landing to La Perouse Bay
Main, T. H.

This sheet supplies the $3\frac{1}{2}$ mile gap left in the shore line between two pieces of work previously surveyed by the C. & G. Survey.

The coast throughout this section is low & level, thickly wooded with algaroba on the northern part of the work & gradually becoming more thinly wooded toward the south. The shore line is sand with the exception of a few distinctive rock ledges projecting out on the southern half of the coast line.

A pulling boat landing has recently been built at Keawakafo.

Arrangements have been made to improve the boat landing at Kihai in the near future. When this landing becomes serviceable, the one at McGregor's will undoubtedly be abandoned.

The rainfall in this section is very light & falls during the kona weather season. Under favorable conditions the country affords excellent grazing for cattle but during the regular trade wind season, which is by far the greater part of the year, it is a desert.
