DESCRIPTIVE REPORT

surveyed September - October, 1924, Eoline R. Hand C of Party

This is a survey of the shoreline only, between the above limits, for the purpose of locating hydrographic signals, and of showing in accurate and close detail landing possibilities along this stretch: executed for military purposes. The traverse is controlled by the triangulation points shown.

As the main function of this party is the detailed hydrographic survey, for military purposes, the bulk of the information will be embodied in my report accompanying hydrographic sheet No. 4, the complement to this sheet.
